May 6, 2021



- Tuesday, April 20 **St. Francis Wolf Sanctuary, Navasota**
We had a great time "meeting" the resident wolves, wolfdogs, and dog. Everyone learned a lot about these animals, and gained an understanding of why they end up in a sanctuary, and why they cannot be returned to the wild.
