The HAWC headquarters are located on Waugh Drive, while the resident shelter itself is at another location. To ensure the safety of the residents, the shelter address is not easily accessible, the building is not visible from the street, and visitors enter the gated property only after passing a security check.

The shelter is currently at capacity, housing 120 residents, including children. An additional building is under construction; when completed, a total of 360 residents can be accommodated.
